Houston Juniors VBC is also home to Tara Cross-Battle, a four-time Olympian and four-time All-American and two-time Player of the Year and volleyball Hall of Fame player 2014. These scholarship offers are just a few of the most recent testaments to the caliber of the Houston Juniors training program, athletes, and coaches. This year in 2021, Houston Juniors VBC is home to the first ever State and National Gatorade Player of the Year, Ally Batenhorst.
